



Dear Referee

Logan Basketball Referee Committee would like to thank you for your efforts as a referee during our 2011 season and look forward to your continued support as a referee on all levels of our club and representative year in 2012.

We would like to advise you that Logan Basketball Association Management committee has given approval to our Referee Committee to adopt the new Basketball Queensland Referee Education Matrix as well as a new payment schedule which will be introduced at the start of the new 2012 season.

In line with the new [Basketball Queensland Referee Education Matrix](#) each referee will be assigned a new qualification title which then identifies the level and standard of game they are qualified to officiate. All Referee's both Junior and Senior will be advised of their new qualification title by email before the commencement of the new 2012 season.

You should have received a Referee Registration form and the new Matrix. The form needs to be filled out and handed back immediately to the Court Controller. This will enable us to introduce a Logan Referee Data Base which will allow us to track the development, growth and education of our Referee's on all Levels. This data base will also be forwarded to Basketball Queensland when completed.

As previously stated a new payment schedule has been approved by Logan Basketball Association Management committee. This new referee payment schedule will run parallel with the BQJBC representative, QBL and Development League payment schedule.

For example –

- A Development Referee at BQJBC is paid \$14.00 for a 90 minute game time (stopped clock).
- A Development Referee at Club will be paid \$6.00 for a 40 minute game time (running clock).

Logan Basketball are fully aware that we do not have enough qualified officials to meet the demand of our representative teams and local junior and senior competitions and must use the officials who are available.

We will endeavour with the help of BQ to establish an education program to overcome this shortfall of qualified officials

Sometimes it may require that we may have to appoint less qualified officials on higher standard games or in the case of our representative games use over qualified officials on some junior games. Officials will still be paid at their specified level.

Evaluations will be done throughout the year at club, representative and state competitions, enabling referee's to advance should they meet the criteria and standard required.

The Referee Committee is also calling for nominations for delegates. The following positions are available and interested applicants should apply in writing to – [admin@loganbasketball.com](mailto:admin@loganbasketball.com) by the 25<sup>th</sup> February 2012. Successful applicants will be advised by the 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2012.
